MEETINGS OVER 5000 PEOPLE ARE PROHIBITED IN FRANCE UNTIL APRIL 15 OVER COVID-19

716 CASES AND 11 DEATH ON MARCH 7th

The death toll in France increased a little more this Saturday, March 7 (afternoon, 3pm), from 9 to 11 dead since yesterday. Hundread and three (103) cases of additional contaminations were noted, passing from 613 to 716. The two new deaths come from Normandy and Hauts-de-France. Gatherings of over 5,000 people banned until mid-April. The ban on gatherings of more than 5,000 people in a closed environment is in effect until April 15, according to the Official Journal, and no longer until May 31. Last ban to date: the Mondial du tattoo, which was to take place from March 13 to 15 at the Grande halle de la Villette, in Paris. The lack of masks worries some professionals. Several representatives of the medical and social professions, in contact with patients, are protesting against the unavailability of protective masks, which they consider necessary to protect themselves from the Covid-19 virus. Concerts, matches, shows... Many rallies have been postponed, or even canceled, due to the Covid-19 epidemic that is hitting France. The Paris marathon, which was to bring together around 60,000 registrants on April 5, has been postponed to October 18, announced the organizer Amaury Sport Organization (ASO), which had already made the decision last weekend to cancel the half-marathon in the streets of the capital.

FOOTBALL MATCHES CANCELLED-----

Currently, in football, only the Ligue 2 Chambly-Le Mans match is behind closed doors. The meeting will take place in Beauvais, in one of the departments most affected by the new coronavirus. The rest of the Ligue 1 and Ligue 2 matches will normally take place this weekend. In basketball, a Jeep Elite match between ASVEL and AS Monaco has been postponed to Tuesday March 10 at 8 p.m. The French team judo championships, scheduled for the weekend of Saturday March 7 and Sunday March 8 in Brest, in Finistère, have been postponed to the fall. The Tarn-et-Garonne prefecture has decided to cancel the French Cross Championships in Montauban, also scheduled for this weekend of March 7 and 8. The match of the Strasbourg-Paris SG French Championship, scheduled for Saturday at 5.30 p.m. (4.30 p.m. GMT), has been postponed because of the risks of the spread of the new coronavirus, the Professional Football League (LFP) announced Friday evening.

FRENCH ARTISTS POSTPONED THEIR CONCERTS OVER TWITTER DUE TO COVID-19 OUTBREAK-----

The famous singer, Maitre Gims, announced himself to his fans, and up to 2.8 million followers on Twitter, that he postpones his future concerts, over his "Decade Tour" tour is « . It is just postponed to June 2020, but not canceled. Je also protect yourself, pay attention [...] I am disgusted with what is going on. And the rap star to announce his new dates on another post, from June 3 in Bordeaux to July 3 in Marseille. The 10th edition of « Rock the ski slopes », in the open air at the Franco-Swiss ski area of "Portes du Soleil", scheduled for March 15 to 21, will not take place: the Swiss authorities have prohibited "any event hosting more than 1,000 people", reminds management. The AccorHotels Arena in Paris Bercy has simply decided to postpone all of its scheduled shows until the end of May. Among them, the concert of the group Tryo in particular, postponed to May 23, that of Matt Pokora, the French singer, also his concert to postponed to June 19, or even that of the singer Ninho, postponed to September 21. According to Le Figaro, the AccorHotels Arena will close its doors to twenty shows: Andrea Bocelli, Ateez, Les Cowboys fringants, Maluma, Roméo Elvis, Fun Radio Ibiza Experience, Harlem Globetrotters 2020, Within Temptation & Evanescence, Niska, Dua Lipa, Harry Styles, Queen + Adam Lambert and « La Nuit de l'Algerie ». Cancellations whose bill is already estimated at 250 million euros, according to the unions. The show « La Nuit de la Bretagne », initially scheduled for March 7 at Paris La Défense Arena, will ultimately not take place. As for the next movie, James Bond the release of No Time to Die has been postponed from April to November. Two other releases (Miss by Ruben Alvès and Rocks by Sarah Gavron) were reported by their producers, while some 145 cinemas in Oise and Morbihan, two departments particularly affected, were closed.
